Duties and Responsibilities:

- 1. Coordinates with office to transport vehicles to Recon
- 2. Ensures all sale vehicles are labeled with proper stickers
- 3. Acts as a Lane Leader on sale day
- 4. Responsible for tracking and lining up vehicles in sale and ensuring they are safe to drive
- 5. Coordinates with office regarding tows and repairs
- 6. Responsible for all Repo vehicle keys
- 7. Puts gas in all sale vehicles
- 8. Performs other related duties as assigned.
